 Host school visits by luge athletes in the Fall of 2024 to introduce the sport.

- 12:45 am - 12:45 pm: Mixed Singles Race
- 12:45 - 1:15 pm: Awards Ceremony
- 1:15 - 2:15 pm: Mini relay race, snow luge activity, and roller luge activity

Activities:

Cheer for a designated country with provided flags.

Meet and greet with Canadian athletes and athletes from the chosen country.

Opportunity to try Snow Luge (weather dependent), coached by Olympians and coaches.

Explore the Whistler Sliding Centre with tours of the track, refrigeration plant, and timing tower.

Each student will receive two tickets to attend additional races on February 7-8, 2025
